What are cookies

Cookies are widely used and are small files that are installed on a computer or mobile device when an individual visits a website. Cookies allow websites to recognise that a user on an individual computer has previously visited the site. They, also, perform other useful tasks, such as keeping track of choices you make during your visit to that website, letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, generally improving your experience, and ensuring that adverts you see online are more relevant to you and your interests.

Consent

When you first visit www.goepcleeds.co.uk or any of their sub domains (the Website) you will be asked to give consent for the use of cookies in accordance with our policy. You can choose not to consent and turn off cookies at that time or at any other time or you can refrain from using the Website. Most browsers allow you to turn off cookies, but this may restrict your use of the Website and/or delay or affect the way in which it operates.

How we use cookies

We use cookies to make interactions with the Website easy and meaningful. Standing alone, cookies do not personally identify you, they merely recognise your Web browser. Unless you choose to identify yourself to Go EPC Leeds, either by responding to a promotional offer or filling out a web form you remain anonymous to Go EPC Leeds.

We use cookies that are session-based. Session cookies exist only during one session. They disappear from your computer or device when you close your browser software or turn off your computer.

We use different categories of cookies:

- Necessary – Necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.
- Preferences – Preference cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Log Files, IP Addresses, URLs and Other Data

As with most websites, we gather certain information to help us analyse trends in the aggregate and administer the Website. This may include your Internet Protocol (IP) address (or the proxy server you use to access the World Wide Web), device and application identification numbers, your location, your browser type, your Internet service provider and/or mobile carrier, the pages and files you viewed, your searches, your operating system and system configuration information, and date/time stamps associated with your usage. Due to Internet communications standards, when you visit or use the Website, we automatically receive the URL of the website from which you came and the website to which you go when you leave our Website. This information is used to analyse overall trends, to help us improve the Website, to track and aggregate non-personal information, and to provide the Websites and Services.
